

## **Wild Blueberry Blight Line Information**

Monilinia apothecial cups are believed to be dried up in the sites that we monitor in Nova Scotia. Therefore disease risk is minimal. This will be the last Monilinia Update for 2009.

Disease symptoms should be appearing soon from infections that took place in early to mid May. Growers should check their fields for monilinia symptoms.

Botrytis blight monitoring will begin in the Parrsboro area on Wednesday, May 27<sup>th</sup>. The first Botrytis Report will be issued on Thursday, May 28<sup>th</sup> in the early afternoon.
